Winter Warming Recipe

Ground Beef & Pasta Skillet

Serves 4

- 1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 pound 90% lean ground beef
- 8 ounces mushrooms, finely chopped or \Rightarrow pulsed in a food processor
- ½ cup diced onion
- 115-ounce can no-salt-added tomato sauce
- 1 cup water
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning \Rightarrow
- ¾ teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon garlic powder \Rightarrow
- 8 ounces whole-wheat rotini or fusilli
- ½ cup shredded extra-sharp Cheddar cheese



Directions

- Heat oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add beef, mushrooms and onion and cook, stirring, until the beef is no longer pink and the mushroom liquid is mostly evaporated, 8 to 10 minutes.
- Stir in tomato sauce, water, Worcestershire, Italian seasoning, salt and gar-2. lic powder.
- 3. Add pasta. Bring to a boil.
- 4. Cover, reduce heat and cook, stirring once or twice, until the pasta is tender and most of the liquid is absorbed, 16 to 18 minutes.
- 5. Sprinkle the pasta with cheese, cover and cook until the cheese is melted, 2 to 3 minutes more.
- Garnish with basil, if desired. 6.
